AGM

Parish Electoral Roll

At the beginning of each year we update the Parish Electoral Roll. To hold a position on parish council or vote at Annual General Meeting or in parish elections you must be registered on the Parish Electoral Roll.

To be registered on the roll you must have completed the Declaration Form confirming that you

1. have been baptised
2. are 18 years of age or older
3. are a member of the Anglican Church (baptised, confirmed or received)
4. are a regular worshipper in this parish and
5. are not on the electoral roll of any other parish.

Copies of the Declaration form and the current roll are available from the parish office or the foyer notice board at church. Please note that no changes to the Electoral Roll are permitted in the 30 days prior to the AGM which means the closing date will be 1st Feb 2019.
